Type of Quilt	Purpose	Inches	Centimeters
<b>Baby Quilt</b>	Suitable for newborns or small babies and small quilts or baby blanket	30×40	76×101
<b>Crib Quilt</b>	Suitable size for larger babies and cot bed or crib mattresses	36×52	91×132
<b>Lap Quilt</b>	Suitable for use in chairs to cover one person's lap and legs	45×45	114×114
<b>Throw Quilt</b>	Suitable for throwing over a couch and covering more than one person	50×65	127×165
<b>Twin-size Quilt</b>	Suitable for twin beds or toddler bed and use as a throw quilt	70×90	178×229
<b>Double Quilt</b>	Suitable for double beds/full-size quilt and use as a large throw quilt	85×108	216×274
<b>Queen bed Quilt</b>	Suitable for a queen-sized bed or as a large throw queen size quilt	90×108	229×274
<b>King-Size Quilts</b>	Suitable for a king-sized bed or larger quilt	110×108	279×274
